Mr. Donald J. Trump, President of the United States, signed the tax bill into law on 22 December 2017, marking the most drastic changes to the U.S. tax code in the past 30 years. In addition to the tax cut, a number of unconventional foreign and domestic policies are also introduced.

At the upcoming Financial Services Interest Group annual cocktail reception, Mr. Peter Wong, Director of The Lion Rock Institute, will share his insights about the captioned subject, highlighting the following aspects:
