## The Haunting Past: Tales of Hong Kong street names



Numerous streets have been laid out in Hong Kong, Kowloon and New Territories over the years accompanying the continuous development and population growth of the city. Nomenclature of them is done by the government following a certain pattern which varied for different districts and at different periods of time. While tens of thousands of Hong Kongers are commuting in the city every day, few of us have any knowledge on the origin of the streets where we live and work.

At the upcoming Property, Infrastructure and Construction Interest Group annual cocktail reception, Prof. Ting Sun Pao, Joseph (丁新豹教授) will talk about the origin of some of the earlier streets in Hong Kong, by highlighting the following aspects:

- nomenclature of the streets;
- evolution of the street naming patterns over the years, with emphasis on its relationship with the colonial government's governing policy;
- some streets with interesting Chinese translated names.

### **ABOUT THE SPEAKER**

Prof. Ting Sun Pao, Joseph (丁新豹教授)
Adjunct Professor and Senior Research Fellow
History Department, The Chinese University of Hong Kong

Prof. Ting graduated from the University of Hong Kong with B.A. in 1974, MPhil in 1979 and PhD in 1989. He served as the Chief Curator of the Hong Kong Museum of History from 1995 to 2007, during which he played a vital role in the planning and implementation of the new Hong Kong Museum of History premises, Hong Kong Museum of Coastal Defense and Hong Kong Sun Yat-sen Museum. Prof. Ting is currently a Hon. Adviser of Hong Kong Museum of Art and Museum of History, Trustee of the Lord Wilson Heritage Trust, Member of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) Museums Advisory Committee, as well as Hon. Adviser or Committee Member of a couple of local museums and museums on the Mainland. He is also a former member of Antiquities Advisory Board and Intangible Cultural Heritage Committee.

Apart from cultural development, Prof. Ting also devotes himself in education and research. He is an Adjunct Professor and a Senior Research Fellow at the History Department of the Chinese University of Hong Kong, Hon. Professor of School of Chinese, the University of Hong Kong, and a member of History Subject Committee of History Department of Lingnan University and City University of Hong Kong, Hon Fellow of the University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong University of Education and Hong Kong Branch of the Royal Asiatic Society, Deputy Director of Hong Kong Local Records Project.

Prof. Ting's field of research covers history of Hong Kong, Guangzhou and Macau, overseas Chinese communities, Dr. Sun Yat-sen and Hong Kong, as well as China trade paintings, etc. Since retirement in 2007, he has published more than ten books among which two books were granted the Book Award of the Year.
