# **About the topic**

The ESG (environmental, social and governance) reporting requirements under the listing rules were upgraded for accounting period beginning 1 January 2016. Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing (HKEX) has recently published an <u>Analysis of ESG Practice Disclosure in 2016/2017</u>. The report indicates, among other things, ways in which listed companies could improve their disclosures. As ESG reporting is still a relatively new area of reporting for Hong Kong, listed companies will benefit from additional guidance and pointers on preparing a credible ESG report.
