Cantonese opera was officially inscribed onto UNESCO Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity in 2009, making it the first item of the world intangible cultural heritage in Hong Kong. With the assistance of the West Kowloon Cultural District Authority, veteran speakers from the industry have been invited to share stories behind the stage curtains. Participants may also have the exclusive opportunity to try on Cantonese opera costumes.
