The rapid growth of the digital economy poses challenges for international taxation. In order to understand and help address these challenges, under Action 1 of the Base Erosion and Profit Shifting (BEPS) initiative, the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) published "Addressing the Tax Challenges of the Digital Economy" Final Report in 2015. More recently, the OECD has issued "Tax Challenges Arising from Digitalisation - Interim Report 2018", to further analyse the evolution of new business models and the potential tax implications of those models.
