

Capital vs Revenue Income - A Review of Precedent Cases

Distinction between what is capital income and what is not has been argued and debated in numerous court cases. Conclusion in a particular case is usually based on a balanced judgment of the facts of that case. The arguments and conclusions presented in these cases provide some guiding principles in making a distinction, yet no single simple test can be used in all circumstances. In this seminar, the speaker will discuss the principles established in the leading case law.
