The <u>Reverse Mortgage Programme</u> ("RMP") [安老按揭計劃] is operated by the Hong Kong Mortgage Corporation Insurance Limited, enabling people who are aged 55 or above to apply for reverse mortgage loans, which allows them to borrow money against the value of their residential properties, as a lump-sum and/or a regular stream of monthly payouts – while they can live in the property for the rest of their life with no loan repayment.

The Property, Infrastructure and Construction Interest Group ("PICIG") is organizing a seminar to introduce the key features and advantages of RMP and compare it with other investment options for retirement.
