2. Guests should be over 18 years old.
3. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
4. Application by fax will **ONLY** be accepted when payment is made by credit card. Cash is strictly not accepted.
5. Confirmation of enrolment will be sent to you via email before 24 January. You can check your enrolment status at "MyCPA" at www.hkicpa.org.hk. Unsuccessful enrolment will be notified with full refund.
6. In normal circumstance, the admission fee is non-refundable or non-transferrable upon receipt of payment by HKICPA. Should the event be cancelled or postponed due to unforeseen circumstance, refund will be made according to your payment method.
