Recent Hong Kong profits tax developments on the fund regime

About the topic

The Council of the European Union ("EU") has identified Hong Kong's current profits tax exemption regime for offshore privately offered funds to be problematic on account of their ring-fencing features. The Inland Revenue (Profits Tax Exemption for Funds) (Amendment) Bill 2018 was introduced in 2018 (the "Bill"). The key objectives of the Bill is to make necessary changes to remove the ring-fencing tax features for fund entities while leaving intact other features under the existing tax regimes that are not related to fund entities per se. Changes on certain tax treatments for funds were also proposed so that Hong Kong would remain competitive in the face of the increasing regional and international competition.

In this seminar, the speaker will walk you through the key Hong Kong profits tax developments on the fund regime as a result of the introduction of the Bill.
