The Institute introduced Sustainability and Social Responsibility Awards as part of the Best Corporate Governance Awards (BCGA) in 2011, in view of the increasing importance of sustainability considerations to listed companies and public sector organisations, investors and the wider community. Putting in place good sustainability practices is not simply a matter of compliance with codes, but good sustainability practices can foster greater investor and stakeholder confidence in listed companies and public sector organisations, as well as the market as a whole. The Institute's sustainability awards are highly sought after, because winning an award is seen by awardees as recognition that they have the highest standards of ESG among their peers.

The speaker(s) in the seminar are highly experienced in assessing companies' ESG in the context of the BCGA. They will share tips on how the Institute assesses the quality of sustainability and social responsibility reporting and what distinguishes the award winners.
