# Latest Tax Controversy Landscape in Mainland China

## About the topic

Over 20,000 province/city/district-level state and local tax bureaus in Mainland China underwent a merger in 2018. After the merger, the two different tax administration and information systems became one. The merger led to reduction of reporting duplication and disputes due to different tax administration standards. Nevertheless, a more efficient system may lead to more comprehensive tax review and audits and hence taxpayers may face new challenges on their tax compliance management.

In this seminar, the speaker will share with you what the new challenges are and how to cope with these changes. The following topics will be covered in the seminar:

- Overview on new tax audit regime under the new administration and how to cope with these new changes
