# Insolvency Practitioners' Personal Liability for Costs in Litigation

### **About the topic**

It is quite common for insolvency practitioners initiate proceedings to recover assets or claim compensation on behalf of an insolvent company. However, if the proceedings fail and the insolvent company does not have sufficient funds to settle the related costs, the insolvency practitioner potentially becomes personally liable for the costs of the action.

There has been increasing debate as to whether it is reasonable for insolvency practitioners to have bear personal liability for such costs in the event that a recovery action is unsuccessful. What is the current legal position and what are the options and considerations for insolvency practitioners?
