- 2. This event is subject to cancellation should the minimum number is not reached.
- 3. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
- 4. The closing date for enrolment is <u>17 July 2019</u>. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late enrolments after the closing deadline as it sees fit.
- 5. Successful registrants will receive confirmation by email or by telephone, whereas unsuccessful registrants will receive full refund.
