The **Bowling Interest Group (BoIG)** invites you to join the Bowling Summer League to be held between July and November 2019. You may form your own team or we can team you up with other bowlers.

Dates:	26 July; 2, 16 & 23 August; 6, 20 & 27 September; 4, 11, 18 & 25 October; 1 November 2019 (all Fridays; 12 sessions)
Time:	8:00 pm – 9:30 pm (starts promptly at 8:00 pm)
Venue:	South China Athletic Association Bowling Centre (SCAA)
Assembly time and place:	7:30 pm at Section <u>A</u> area of SCAA
Fee:	 \$1,950 per player Fixed fee. No pro rata payment or refund for not being able to participate in all sessions. \$14 for shoes rental per session is not included.
No. of team:	 Min 8 teams (max 10)
Format:	 Each team comprises of 2 players. A team can have a maximum of 2 reserve players. (* Individual players will be grouped together to form a team.) A total of 12 sessions will be held in the league season. Each player plays 3 games per session, with a handicap in each session. Detailed league rules will be distributed to registered players. (* To comply with the lane booking requirement, at least one member of each team needs to be a current member of SCAA. If none, one of the team members has to join SCAA membership at his/her own cost at HK\$120 per year for ordinary member.
Prizes:	 Team Champion, 1st Runner-Up and 2nd Runner-up Individual men and ladies high series Individual best improved players Weekly high game winners (Details of the prize presentation are to be confirmed after the league.)
Remark:	 The league results will be used as reference for the selection of representative team members for future external competitions including the Recreation and Sports Club for HK Professional Bodies Tournament.

- 1. Registration is on a first-come first-served basis. Priority entry will be offered to Bowling Interest Group members and then to non-BoIG HKICPA members.
- 2. This event is subject to cancellation should the minimum number is not reached.
- 3. The Institute has the discretion to accept late enrolments after the closing deadline as it sees fit.
- 4. Unless the activity is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, low enrollment or bad weather, no withdrawal will be entertained after the enrollment has been processed.
- 5. Bad weather arrangement: The activity will be cancelled if typhoon signal no. 8 or above / Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted at or after 6:00 pm on the date of the activity.
- 6. The Institute reserves the right to change the venue and date of the course due to unforeseen circumstances.
