Awards

Charles Mar Fan Cup will be awarded to the champion. Trophies will be awarded to the champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up. Medals will also be presented to players of the top 4 teams.

Briefing Session

A team briefing will take place in mid of October to consider and adopt the competition rules, drawing of groups and match schedule.

Enrolment Notes

- Signed health declaration and disclaimer of liability form together with payments should be submitted to the Institute on or before the enrolment closing date, i.e. 9 October 2019. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late applications as it sees fit.
- 2. Enrolment fee of \$1,300 per team is non-refundable once the enrolment is processed.
- 3. Each team has to pay an additional deposit of \$500 which is refundable. The deposit will therefore be forfeited in the following circumstances if any team has:
 - failed to show up at any scheduled match;
 - made any unsubstantiated complaints; or
 - been found guilty of breaching of the rules and regulations of the competition.

Otherwise, the deposit will be refunded in full after the competition.

- 4. All players are required to present their HKID card or passport for identification purpose before the commencement of the match. The name appears on the List of Players should be identical to the name appears on the identification proof.
- 5. Upon submission of the online enrolment form, the Team Leader confirms the particulars entered in the List of Players are true and accurate
- 6. Should the Team Leader wish to make any changes to the List of Players that has already been submitted, he is required to submit an Application for Change of Players to the Institute before 29 October 2019. No changes will be accepted thereafter. The final composition of a team must comply fully with the Team Requirements as set out below.
- 7. Only players who have been duly registered are allowed to play in the competition.
- 8. All players must sign the health declaration and disclaimer of liability form. The signed form must reach the Institute by 21 October 2019, by fax or email to betsyliang@hkicpa.org.hk the latest, otherwise the team will be considered as withdrawal from the competition and the paid enrolment fee will be forfeited.
- The rules of the competition will be sent to all participating teams. The Institute reserves the rights to revise or amend the rules of the competition without prior notice and its interpretation is deemed to be final.
- The venue and date of match are subject to change without prior notice due to unforeseen circumstances.
- 11. Email will be used for all communications about the competition except on the event date when mobile messages will be used.

Team Requirements

Participating team should fulfill the following requirements:-

- 12. A team can be comprised of the following two types of players:
 - HKICPA members
 - HKICPA QP students / graduates

- 13. Each team can register a maximum of 15 players. Each team must have at least 7 players during a match, of which a minimum of 3 HKICPA members must be playing at any time throughout the match.
- 14. The Institute will, base on the information stated in the enrolment form / Change of Players List, to consider if a team has complied with the requirement set out in point 12 above. Therefore any players who expect their status to be changed by 2 November 2019 (first match) should use the new status to enter into the competition.
- 15. One can notify the Institute of his change of status by completing the Change of Players List by **29 October 2019**. Any subsequent change of status will not be entertained.
- 16. A team must have a Team Leader who is a HKICPA member.
- 17. A player can only register for one team.

Personal Data:

Your personal data collected from the enrolment process and administration of courses/events/activities will be used for the purpose of the administration of the course/event/activity on which you are enrolled ("Event"). Such data collected may be accessible by the Institute's officers, persons or committees processing the application and related matters. In addition, the Institute may use the collected data for statistical research and analysis. By submitting this Enrolment Form, you understand and agree that the Institute may provide your personal data above to co-organisers/service providers in or outside Hong Kong for the purpose relating to the Event.
