

What you need to know about the new revenue and leases accounting standards as tax professionals (rerun)

About the topic

HKFRS 15 *Revenue from Contracts with Customers* has fundamentally changed the basis of revenue recognition while HKFRS 16 *Leases* requires nearly all leases be recognized on the balance sheet of lessees. The changes brought about by the new HKFRS 15 and HKFRS 16 on financial reporting would likely lead to mismatch on timing and classification of revenue and expenses for tax and accounting purposes. It is therefore important for tax professionals to have a decent knowledge of the new standards, appreciate what impacts they bring and key areas that could be overlooked easily for tax computation preparation.

The speaker will go through the following topics in the seminar:

- Overview of the key requirements of HKFRS 15 and HKFRS 16;
- Using practical examples to illustrate how the new revenue standard may accelerate or decelerate revenue recognition in different industries and settings, including changes to royalty and license payments, non-refundable upfront fees and breakage; and
- Summary of the main changes brought by HKFRS 16, including new requirements relating to sub-leasing and sale and leaseback.
