#### Workshop on IFRS/HKFRS 17 – Life Insurance Business: deep dive application

Topics include:

- An overview of relevant fundamentals of the Standard including IFRS 17 measurement models.
- Variable Fee Approach, CSM calculation, coverage unit determination, risk adjustment and discounting for typical life insurance fact patterns, for example, for groups of contracts containing different contracts with a range of services and benefits.
- Expense allocation and how to determine whether experience adjustments are related to current/past or future services in typical fact patterns.
- Practical insights, which will be illustrated via example fact patterns for items such as indirect participating 'investment-linked' contracts and the potential income statement impact, interaction with IFRS/HKFRS 9 *Financial Instruments*, CSM amortisation, etc.
