

# **Insolvency Preparatory II** (Webinar)

The Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants invites applications for the Insolvency Preparatory II. The course will be held on five Saturday mornings commencing 27 March 2021. Upon completion of the course, a certificate of attendance will be awarded to each participant who has fulfilled the minimum 80% attendance.

This course offers an in-depth and integrated study of the financial, management, legal and accounting aspects of insolvency administration with specific emphasis on the practical issues relating to these areas. A multiple-choice test on understanding and assimilation of the knowledge taught will be held at the end of the course. Those who are interested in continuing their study in HKICPA's Professional Diploma in Insolvency programme but with less than 2 years of insolvency work experience, successful completion of Insolvency Preparatory II and a passing score on the multiple-choice test will make one eligible for admission to the diploma programme.
