Business valuation is the process of determining the economic value or worth of a business. In complex disputes, there is often debate over the appropriate valuation approach to adopt, assumptions, comparability and sufficiency of data, etc.

In this webinar, the speakers will talk about the general litigation/ arbitration process related to valuation, and at which stage valuation experts will come in. They will also share their experiences on contentious issues typical in a litigation setting (e.g. the application of discounts due to lack of control and marketability) and share their views as to why valuation experts may disagree, despite having access to the same set of factual information.
