- Topics on HKFRS 9
 - Consideration in applying the solely payments of principal and interest (SPPI) test in money market fund and other financial products
 - Classification of financial assets for (1) instruments that are classified as equity by issuer but cannot be designated as an investment at fair value through other comprehensive income; and (2) perpetual instruments or preference shares with dividend pushers or dividend stoppers
 - Expected credit losses: impact of collateral on the assessment of credit risk
 - Disclosures in respect of financial guarantee contracts
- Topics on HKFRS 15
 - Principal versus agent consideration
 - Identification of performance obligations
 - Disclosures in respect of HKFRS 15
