

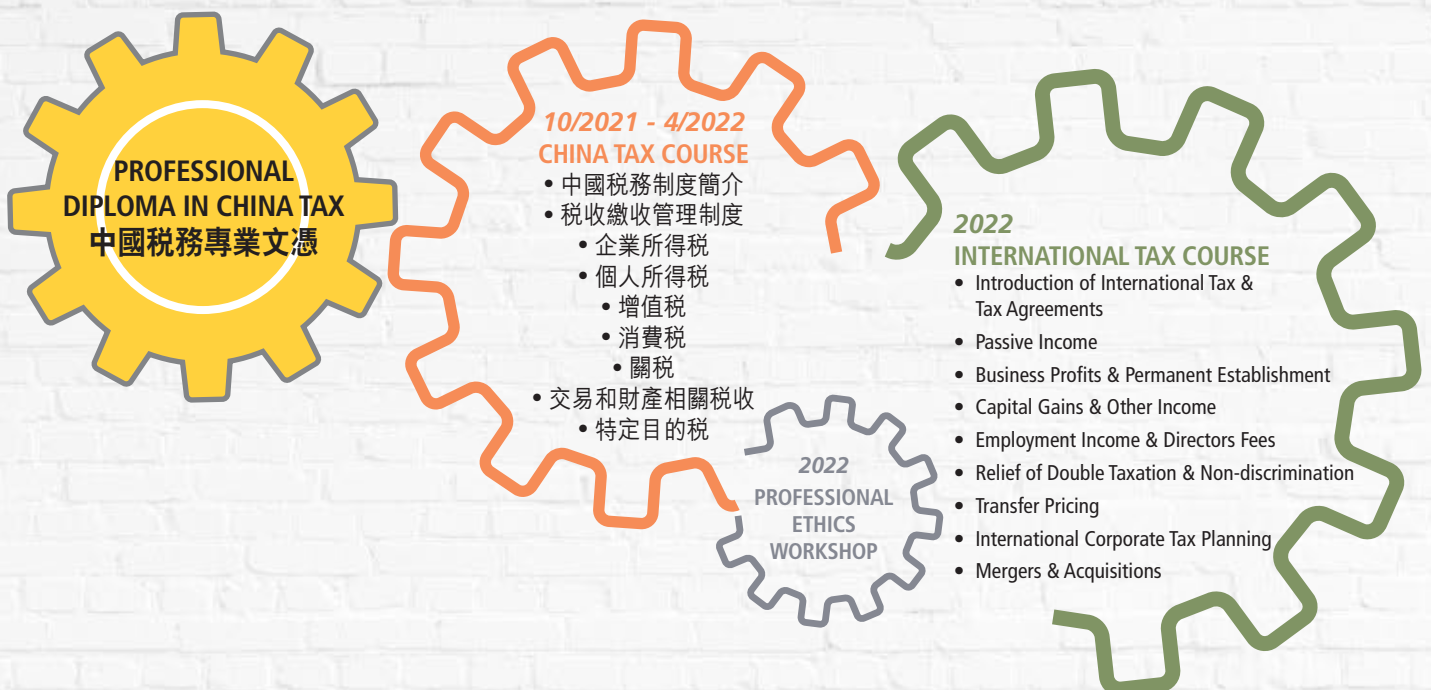


# 中國稅務專業文憑
