As a decade-long Bitcoin advocator, Mr. Yeung has researched, mined and traded Bitcoin since 2011.

Currently, Mr. Yeung is the President of International Division of New Web Group, which is a Web 3.0 infrastructure company in China, backed by the Shenzhen Municipal Government Investment Fund (worth over \$15 billion USD), the Futian District Guidance Investment Fund and QF Venture Capital, one of China's top 6 VC institutions.

In 2017, Mr. Yeung was the Head Executive of the international division of The Jiangsu Huaxin Blockchain Research Institute (JBI), which was a Chinese State Owned Enterprise that researches blockchain and commercializes blockchain-based solution.

Mr. Yeung founded Saftonhouse Consulting Group in 2014, Western Canada's first cryptocurrency and blockchain consultancy.

Mr. Yeung was also the Founder of the Simon Fraser Blockchain Club in 2013, the first university-based association in the world that promotes awareness of Bitcoin, cryptocurrencies, blockchain, and other distributed ledger technologies.

Mr. Yeung appeared frequently in mainstream, international media regarding Bitcoin and related developments since 2013.
