**Perspective of Insolvency Practitioners in dealing with
 Resumption and Delisting of Listed Entities**

About the topic

As part of its efforts to combat shell related activities, Hong Kong Stock Exchange has been adopting a more robust delisting policy to facilitate quicker delisting of issuers that no longer meet the continuing listing criteria. Albeit these changes primarily target shell related activities, they also have an impact on other restructurings, including those arising from insolvency of listed entities. Accordingly, insolvency practitioners (IPs) are facing more challenges and pressure on restructurings of insolvent listed entities, especially on seeking resumptions of trading of these entities.

At this webinar, Mr. Terry Kan from SHINEWING Specialist Advisory Services will briefly explain the current delisting framework, the latest guidance on long suspension and delisting of listed companies and the resumption conditions. He will then share with us the challenges normally faced by IPs and his practical experience on seeking resumption of trading of insolvent listed companies through case studies.
