Master (2 pax. per table)		2:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.	For member who have joined intermediate level and are recommended by the coach.

4. The Institute, convenor of the SnIG or the coach have the discretion to accept late enrolments after the closing deadline as it sees fit.
5. Unless the activity is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, low enrolment or bad weather, no refund for withdrawal will be entertained after the enrolment has been processed.
6. Bad weather arrangement: The activity will be cancelled if typhoon signal no. 8 or above / Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted 2 hours prior to the commencement of the course.
7. The Institute reserves the right to change the venue and date of the course due to unforeseen circumstances.
