Dr. Cyrus TSE was born in Canada and graduated from The University of Toronto with a degree in Bachelor of Science. He subsequently moved back to Hong Kong and received his medical degree from The Chinese University of Hong Kong in 2003. He is a **Specialist in General Surgery** subspecializing in Colorectal Surgery. He has undergone overseas training in some of the top medical centers in both USA and Korea, and is experienced in both minimal invasive and robotic (da Vinci Xi) surgery. He was also one of the first surgeons in Hong Kong to perform Transanal Total Mesorectal Excision (TaTME) back in March 2015. After more than 15 years of practice under the Hospital Authority Dr. Tse entered private practice in 2018.

Dr. Tse has published in various international medical journals and book chapter, and regular speaks at various medical conferences and meetings. He is passionate in teaching and is a regular examiner with both CUHK and HKU's medical school. He is also active in multiple local community services and charity projects.
