Insolvency Preparatory II (Webinar)

May - June 2023

The Institute's Insolvency Preparatory II offers an in-depth and integrated study of the financial, management, legal and accounting aspects of insolvency administration with specific emphasis on the practical issues relating to these areas. Experienced specialists in field of insolvency will share with participants their expertise in different subject areas.

Insolvency Preparatory II will be held on five Saturday mornings commencing 13 May 2023 with topics as followings:

- 1. Duties of Insolvency Administrators
- 2. Creditors' Rights and Claims / **Employee Issues**
- 3. Trading Administrations and Receiverships
- 4. Corporate Rescue
- 5. PRC Insolvency

Multiple-choice test

A multiple-choice test on understanding and assimilation of the knowledge taught will be held at the end of the course.

Those who are interested in continuing their study in HKICPA's Professional Diploma in Insolvency programme but with less than 2 years of insolvency work experience, successful completion of Insolvency Preparatory II and a passing score on the multiple-choice test will make one eligible for admission to the diploma programme.

Format

Live webinar (via Zoom)

Language

English (Cantonese may be used for some topics)

Target participants

All interested parties working in the field of insolvency or related areas who have attained **18 months** of insolvency or related experience; or those who have successfully completed the Insolvency Preparatory I.

CPD hours

15 verifiable CPD hours for Institute's members. A certificate of attendance will be awarded to each participant who has fulfilled the minimum 80% attendance. (Note: The course is under review by the Law Society of Hong Kong as an accredited CPD course.)

Fees

- HK\$3,920 (Non-member)

Enrolment deadline is 8 May 2023. Registrations are on a first-come-first-served basis and priority will be given to candidates who have successfully completed insolvency Preparatory I. The course may be cancelled if the minimum enrolment is not achieved.
