While the International Sustainability Standards Board (ISSB) is expected to finalize its two inaugural standards on general sustainability disclosure requirements (IFRS S1) and climate-related disclosures (IFRS S2) in June 2023, the Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited (HKEX) has recently published a consultation paper to enhance climate disclosures under its ESG Guide to align with IFRS S2 with a proposed effective date of 1 January 2024.

This webinar aims to provide the latest updates on the developments of both the ISSB standards and HKEX's proposals, to explain their impact on corporates as well as the way forward.
