To kick-off this e-Seminar, two respected speakers respectively share their insights and experience on how organizations can embrace sustainability:

- **Let's accelerate sustainability** – As global pressures drive the adoption of broader sustainability initiatives, the power of science, technology, and innovation will be critical to tackling environmental issues. The speaker from IBM shares how his organization aimed to drive societal impact and accelerate sustainability outcomes by applying technologies, such as artificial intelligence, and addresses environmental threats including climate change, extreme weather, and pollution, among others.
- **Building sustainable cities** – As a low-carbon transport service provider, MTR has set forth three environmental and social objectives: (1) Social Inclusion, (2) Advancement and Opportunities, and (3) Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduction, as well as defined 10 focus areas and a set of key performance indicators to create greater impact for society. The speaker from MTR shares their approach to further embedding environmental and social principles within the corporation to deliver value for all of its stakeholders. Initiatives regarding MTR's decarbonization roadmap, as well as social inclusion and empowering people and communities through its network are also discussed.

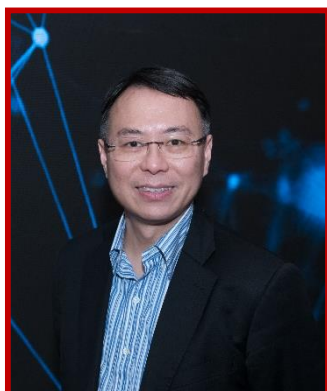
About the Speakers

Ms. Chan is a seasoned sustainability professional with over 25 years of experience in environmental and corporate sustainability with diverse expertise in sustainability strategies and policies, sustainability communications and disclosure, regulatory compliance, stakeholder engagement, and emerging sustainability issues.
