

# Live webinar: Implementing HKSA 315 (Revised 2019) – What you need to know

## COURSE HIGHLIGHTS:

Auditors are now expected to have incorporated the new requirements of HKSA 315 (Revised 2019), *Identifying and Assessing the Risks of Material Misstatement* into their audit engagements, which are effective starting from 2022 audits. These revisions bring renewed emphasis on a client's controls, with a specific focus on the entity's IT environment and IT controls during auditors' risk assessment process. Furthermore, the standard requires a separate assessment of control risk and inherent risk, and requires auditors to assess the inherent risk factors in assessing the latter.

This webinar will begin with an overview of HKSA 315 (Revised 2019). Selected aspects of the standard will be explored in-depth, accompanied by illustrations in order to equip participants with practical insight to implement the new requirements effectively.

To ensure an engaging and interactive learning, a Q&A session will be included for participants to delve deeper into the topic and seek clarification.
