2. Eczema (濕疹)

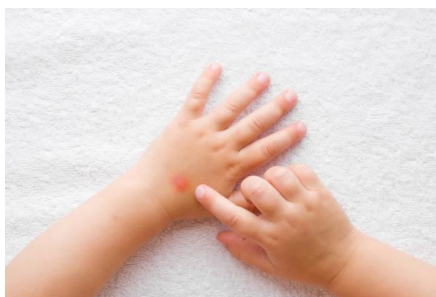
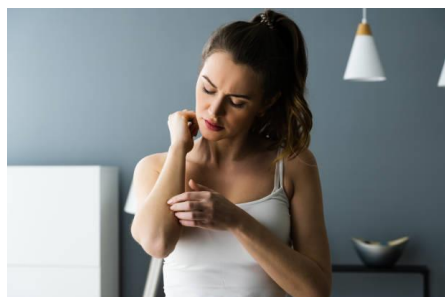
- Anything new about management of eczema in children & adults?
