This e-learning will cover regulatory and market updates relating to investment funds industry with particular reference in the following areas:

Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Authority:

- eMPF Platform – The eMPF Platform (the Platform) project, the largest reform of the MPF System since its inception, is currently under construction. It is a major infrastructure which aims to reshape the administrative models of MPF schemes and to standardize, streamline and automate the existing scheme administrative processes. When the eMPF Platform is fully implemented, it is anticipated to bring tremendous benefits to various stakeholders of the MPF System. The MPFA will share details of the Platform in this webinar.

Hong Kong Monetary Authority & PwC:

- Tax concession for carried interest – In response to industry demand and international competition, the concession would see eligible carried interest exempt from Hong Kong profits tax and excluded from salaries tax.
- In this section, led jointly by the HKMA & PwC, HKMA will share the policy intent and highlight features of the tax concession regime, the guidelines on the auditor's report released in August 2022 for application for certification of funds, as well as issues most relevant to investment funds, their fund managers and practitioners. PwC will share the observations on the current market experience on the concession, the documents to be prepared in applying the exemption and other filing requirements.
