



Accounting and Financial Reporting E-learning: Year-end reminders – Accounting and auditing considerations of HKFRS 17

COURSE HIGHLIGHTS:

HKFRS 17 *Insurance Contracts* became effective from 1 January 2023. It is a comprehensive financial reporting standard that brings about fundamental changes in the accounting for insurance contracts, impacting the entire finance and actuarial reporting processes. Implementing the requirements of HKFRS 17 has been challenging not only for insurers but also for auditors, given the significant complexity associated with HKFRS 17 numbers.

The e-learning will integrate the technicalities of the accounting and auditing considerations. The speaker will provide practical reminders on the key accounting requirements of HKFRS 17 and highlight areas of increased risk of material misstatements in the initial application of HKFRS 17, including opening balances and comparative, and suggest possible audit responses to address those risks. Furthermore, the speaker will explain common issues observed in the initial application of the standard, and how to assess them from the auditor's point of view.
