Transfer Pricing Updates – Getting ready for 2024

About the topic

Over recent months, there have been a number of tax developments that will have transfer pricing (TP) implications and impact on key business decisions. Many jurisdictions have enacted legislation which will impose new taxes on companies. They are issuing new guidance and local rules resulting from the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development's BEPS 2.0 initiative. In particular, the new Global Anti-Base Erosion (GloBE) rules are now being implemented by jurisdictions around the world and the Hong Kong SAR Government has indicated that they will apply in Hong Kong from 2025.

In addition, Operational TP is being introduced to companies to meet the expectations of evidence trails and retention, as well as turn-around times for information requests during tax / TP audits.

In this webinar, the speakers will discuss:

- Recent focus on TP controversy in the Asia Pacific region through practical case sharing
- Technical updates on BEPS 2.0, and the updated timeline for compliance and impact assessment
- Challenges faced by tax and finance departments with limited resources, due to BEPS and details of Operational TP
