About the speaker

Professor Hualing Fu **Dean, Faculty of Law, The University of Hong Kong**

Professor Fu holds the Warren Chan Professorship in Human Rights and Responsibilities with The University of Hong Kong. His current research focuses on the rise of human rights lawyering in China and its implications for political and legal reform in China, the politics of anti-corruption enforcement, popular justice, and a critical re-assessment of rule of law reform in China in the past four decades. His other research areas include the constitutional status of Hong Kong, in particular central-local relationships in the Hong Kong context and national security legislation.

Professor Fu has given expert evidence in a number of cases in the Courts of Hong Kong on PRC State Secret Law. His evidence was accepted by the Courts and form an important part of the judgments.
